NTRODUCTION

BYSTŘICKO (Bystřice region)

The Zubr paths are a complex of unique cycling trips in the Bystrice region. On your bike rides you will be able to see the best of the countryside, which seems to be made for cycling. There is something for nature and history lovers, as well as technical and architectural sights. The region is a part of the Svratecká hornatina nature reserve. When cycling, you will be able to visit the fairytale castle Pernštein. Svratka water-management nature trail around the Vír dam and around the Svratka river, walk up to the top of hills decorated by rocks and observation towers, admire allevs of old trees or seek out memorial stones and conciliation stone from the distant and recent past. You can rest in the EDEN Centre – a centre of green knowledge with a natural chemist, a brewery and a stable. If you want a proper cycling experience, visit the net of single tracks in the Vysočina Arena in the town of Nové Město na Moravě. Since 2015, Bystřicko has been a part of the tourist region Koruna Vysočiny (Crown of the Highlands) which covers the east part of the Czech-Moravian Highlands from Žďárské vrchy to Tišnov. This area unites and represents the best of several regions (Žďársko, Novoměstsko, Bystřicko, Nedvědicko, Tišnovsko, Velkomeziříčsko and Bítešsko) and it connects everyone related to tourism within the regions.



Thanks to the water in the countryside and the way it is presented to visitors through nature trails, the Bystřice region received the title EDEN (European Destination of Excellence) in 2010.

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The Historical Trail

36/47 km


A trail following historical, architectural and technical sights of the region. The shorter version takes you across ruins of Zubštejn and Pyšolec medieval castles, around the Vír dam, along the Svratka water-management nature trail, all the way to Dalečín, and then further to the Romanesque church of St. Michael in Vítochov. The longer version offers beautiful views from Polom and Ubušínek: you can see the Svratka river valley with the Vír dam.



PLACES OF INTEREST

Pivonice – baroque chapel of St. Anna with rococo frescoes and above the village you can see the 14th century castle ruin **Zubštejn**, a popular tourist destination. Further along the trail there is **Pyšolec**, a castle ruin from the 14th century located above the levelling dam of the Vír reservoir. Further on there is **Vír** - a tourist destination with lots of trip possibilities and beautiful views such as Klubačice or Horymírka. Vír is also an ice climbing centre. The ice wall is where the Czech ice climbing championship takes place. There is a curiosity in Vír as well – a small water mill. The reservoir in Vír, which dammed the Svratka river, has the third highest dam in the Czech Republic at 76.5 m high. **Ubušínek** – a village conservation area with folk architecture. **Dalečín** – there is a romantic ruin of the gothic Dalečín castle; a chateau in Tyrole style; a functionalist villa by Gustav Jarošek **Vítochov** – there is a romantic church of St. Michael from the second half of the 13th century.



The Picturesque Trail

A trail around Pernštejn castle, which follows old paths in this varied and indented landscape. There are a lot of historical stone and wooden bridges near and around the castle. The trail will take you to Sýkořice woods, Cheb stream valley and a spring snowflake nature reserve and then to Dolní Čepí – a historic miner's village. To get to know the area around Nedvědice, you can use the Pernštejn nature trail.

PLACES OF INTEREST

Hradisko – between Rožná and Věžná there is an interesting geological locality with a unique lepidolite deposit. **Nedvědice** – gothic Pernštejn castle with castle gardens, a view of Maria Laube and a settlement around the castle. The castle is a popular destination for visitors and film producers. The nature trails around Nedvědice will lead you across wooden and stone bridges, a villa district from the end of the 19th century and a marble quarry. Černvír – a church called Nanebevzetí Panny Marie (Assumption of Virgin Mary) and a unique covered wooden bridge from 1718. **Doubravník** – a church called Povýšení svatého Kříže (The Holy Cross Advancement Church) with the tomb of the Pernstejns and the Mitrovsky family. **Chlébské** – a natural reserve with an endless carpet of spring snowflakes. **Dolní Čepí** – miner's chapel of St Wenceslaw from the 13th century.



The Trail with Views


This is a tip for a cycling trip for those not afraid of riding up hills! Across the deep Svratka valley there are tracks and paths which lead through a hilly terrain to spots with the best views of Bystřicko. The top of the ruin of Zubštejn, the observation towers Horní les and Karasín will provide you with views of the landscape from Brno up to Jeseník. This is a demanding trip which will not disappoint in any season.

Pivonice – the baroque chapel of St. Anna with rococo frescoes and above the village you can see the 14th century castle ruin of **Zubštejn**, a popular tourist destination. **Bolešín** – a unique locality where you can find lady's-slipper orchids near the natural monument Dědkovo. The Fun Trail



PLACES OF INTEREST

Hradisko – between Rožná and Věžná there is an interesting geological locality with a unique lepolite deposit. **Mitrov** – the ruin of Mitrov castle from the 14th century; Mitrovský dvůr farm with a shop selling local products. **Dolní Rožínka** – a castle called Dolní

Rožínka which used to be the residence of the Mitrovský family and is now a school; the forest park nearby shows how the gentry used to like relaxing and spending their free time. The haunted castle Draxmoor is in an old granary and the Krokodýl (Crocodile) Photo Park is in the former stables belonging to the Mitrovský family. Zvole – Šiklův mlýn western city, a large and unique complex with fun for the whole family all day long. In Zvole there is the church of St. Wenceslaw by J. B. Santini, which is a beautiful example of baroque architecture.





PLACES OF INTEREST

The Domanín pond – a natural swimming pool in a serene environment with the option to fish and with accommodion in cabins or in a camp. You can also rent a boat or a paddle boat. In Domanín you can visit a rope park in the forest near the Borovinka recreation facility. There are several circuits in the rope parts suitable for both adults and children. Borovinka – a recreation facility with tennis courts, minigolf, a children's castle and bike rental. Excellent food and a family brewery. Koník Forest District (Koníkovské polesí) – a forest area between Lísek, Vojtěchov and Koníkov where you can find a lot of conciliation stones and memorials, e.g. U Tří srnců (Three Deers), U Pytláka (Poacher), U posledního Vlka (The Last Wolf) or the top of Kamenice with a memorial Broučci (Little Bugs) by Jan Karafiát.



The Sport Trail

A trail connecting Bystřice nad Pernštejnem and Nové Město na Moravě with a lot of places attractive for lovers of various sports. There are also a lot of rest opportunities when visiting the Domanín, Skalský or Zuberský pond. Try cycling on the singletracks in Nové Město or enjoy beautiful folk architecture in Lísek and Koníkov.

The Uranium Trail

A trail connecting the Bystřice and Nedvědice regions. It will take you through places connected to uranium ore mining in the granite massifs in Vysočina. The mine in Rožná is the last active uranium ore mine in central Europe. It is an unusual sight in a beautiful landscape.





Velodrome Vysočina Singletracks - Nové Město na Moravě

The mountain bike trails in Nové Město continues the tradition of MTB racing in Nové Město. The project was created by Lukáš Vlach and Jan Skřička, members of the MTB World Championship organization committee. They designed the trails so that they are enjoyable for a wide range of cyclists.


Everyone can find a suitable trail depending on their level of fitness and technical abilities. There are technically easy, fun and safe trails for children; natural trails suitable for wheelchairs or handbikes designed for cyclists with disabilities; as well as very demanding trails for experienced cyclists. The level of the trails is based on current trends of trails built for the MTB World Championship.

They are open from 15th April to 31st October

The trails are 30 km long with 5 levels of difficulty:

- black (for experienced cyclists, with extreme parts)
- red and orange (for experienced cyclists)
- blue (for beginners)
- green (for disabled cyclists)
- purple (for the youngest)



Long Trails Across Regions

EuroVelo 4

A European trail cutting through the old continent from the west to the east. It is 4000 km long, starting in Roscoff,

a town on the French coast, through Belgium, Germany, to the Czech Republic and then further east to Kiev. This trail also goes through the regions of Nové Město and Bystřice, from Herálec and Koníkov through the Svratka valley all the way to the Pernštejn castle.

The Posázavská Trail (19)

From Bystřice nad Pernštejnem, where it connects with the Czech Trail No. 1, it continues symbolically

to Žďár nad Sázavou around the source of the river Sázava. It then continues to Bohemia and follows Sázava river to where it meets Vltava in Davle. The Posázavská trail is number 19 and it goes through beautiful countryside. It is 245 km long.

Thematic Long Trails

The Miller's Trail

A long cycling trail going across regions. It's main topic is the history of flour milling. The trail starts in Nové Město and continues to the border crossing Čížov-Hardegg. The trail is designed so that it goes along watercourses with old mills, which used to be indispensable in the past. Altogether there are 48 mills in various conditions, and there are other cultural and natural monuments as well. The trail is mostly off-road.

Santini's Trail (5061)

A regional cycle path following the baroque architecture of Jan Blažej Santini. There are remarkable buildings along the path: the church of Jan Nepomucký in Zelená hora (UNESCO), the cemetary church of Holy Trinity in Žďár nad Sázavou, St. Wenceslaw church in Zvole, the Romanesque church of St. Pater and Paul in Horní Bobrová or the church Navštívení Panny Marie (Visit of Virgin Mary) in Obyčtov. This is the right trip for lovers of sacral architecture.

The Eco-Pavilion will introduce you to modern technologies and their methods of using the energy of earth, fire, water and air. Do you know how many meters you need to cycle before you make a gramophone start playing? You don't? So come to the centre. You can also come to regular gastronomic events such as Carnival in February, Harvest Supper in August or Potato Festival in September. You can also ride a horse or taste products from our farm.


